ANGEL LUSH w/PINEAPPLE

- 1 can (20 oz.) Dole Crushed Pineapple, undrained
- 1 pkg. (3.4 oz.) Jell-o Vanilla Flavor Instant Pudding & Pie Filling
- 1 Cup thawed Cool Whip
- 1 pkg. (10 oz.) round angel food cake, cut into 3 layers
- Seasonal Berries

Mix pineapple and dry pudding mix in medium bowl. Gently stir in whipped topping

Stack cake layers on plate, spreading pudding mixture between layers and on top of cake.

Refrigerate 1 hour or until ready to serve.
Garnish with your favorite seasonal berries.
